Emma Caldow is an emerging Scottish Artist, based in Inverness, who focuses on Site-Specificity and Sustainability.

“Working on beaches across Scotland, I am currently exploring the interaction between the Cyanotype Process and Environmental Elements, to create subtly conceptual artworks that capture the Scottish Coastline. The work is made on location, by working with salt water, sand, and wind on the beaches of Scotland. Each work has been formed by exposure to the rushing tide, flickering sun and blustering wind, to truly capture a moment in time.

The cyanotype medium is non-toxic and by utilising the natural environment as the secondary medium, the works are sustainable and environmentally conscious. It encourages the implementation of more sustainable and environmentally conscious methods and materials within Fine Art. It also provokes an appreciation of the beauty and power of the natural environment, which in turn deepens humanity’s consideration of these environments.”

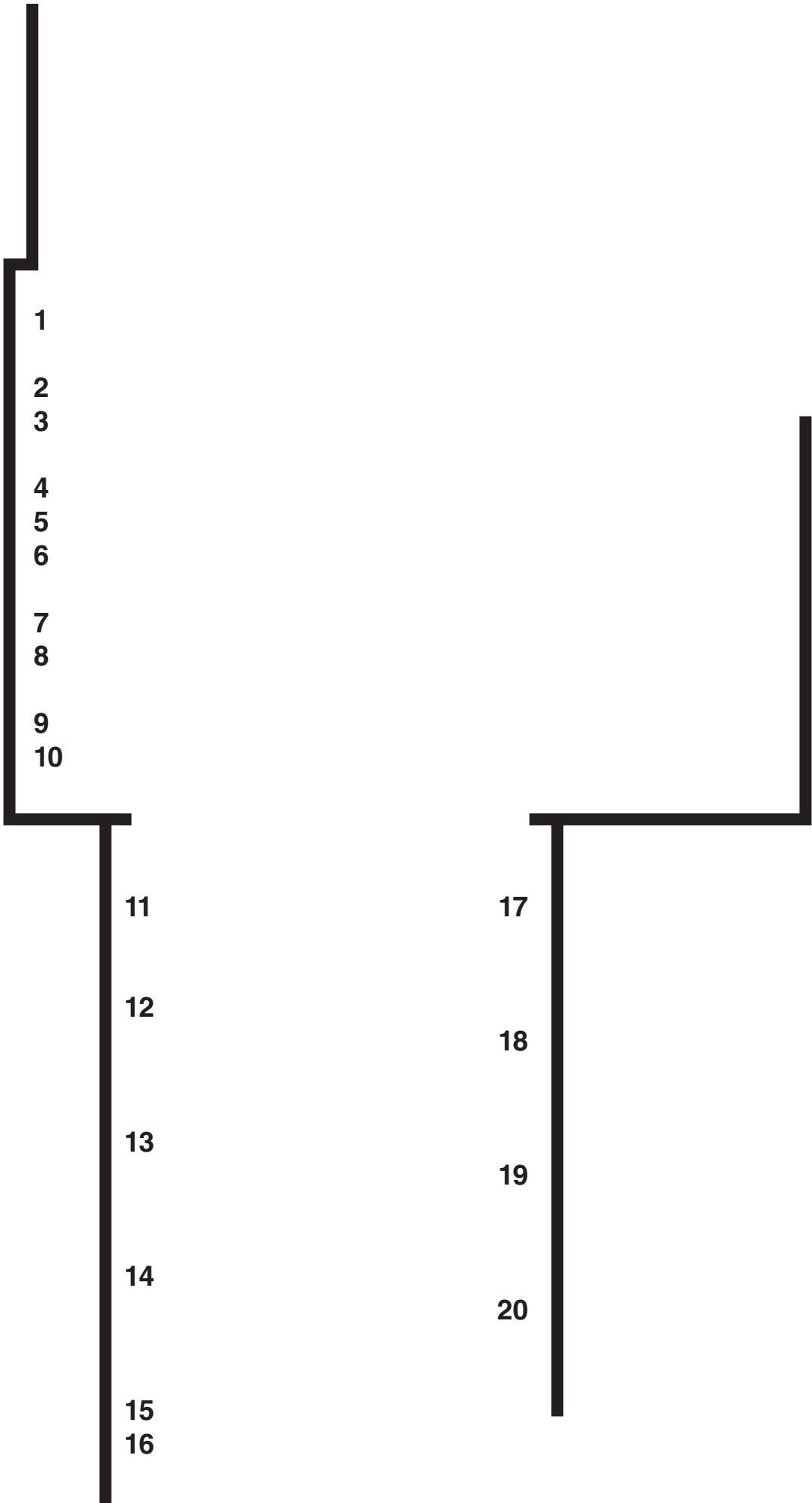
Emma Caldow

Cyanotype Printing

Cyanotype printing is a camera-less photographic technique that involves laying an object on paper coated with a solution of iron salts before exposing it to UV light and washing with water to create stunning white and Prussian blue images. The term ‘blueprint’ comes from the use of Cyanotypes.
